Veronica Roesly from Mercantile Bank will work with Ms. Antor to figure out details of the boards and possibly having a tournament.

New Business:

B-1) Town Wide Yard Sales – The Committee agreed that there will not be booths set up in the park this year for the yard sales. The Village will put on the website to “stay tuned for future details”.

B-2) Music in the Park/National Night Out – The Committee needs to get donations of food (hot dogs, buns, chips, water, condiments) and find someone to cook for the August 6 Music in the Park/National Night Out. Ms. Antor will begin to look for donations and someone to cook. Ms. Antor also volunteered to help contact local municipalities to see if they would like to participate and be honored as well.

B-3) Band Shell – Bryan Cramer is working with Ronna Kilts on getting a pamphlet together to present to area businesses in order to ask for donations toward the band shell. The fundraising is to begin as soon as possible.

The Committee approved the addition of Veronica Roesly as a member of the Park and Rec Committee.

Ms. Antor requested to have another meeting at the end of June to keep everyone up to date as to what is happening and what is still needed to be done by the Committee.
