Council Meeting Minutes
July 16, 2018

President Heckman called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present: Smith, Williams, Hacko, Bassett, Hagstrom and Heckman. Absent: MacTavish.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Motion by Williams seconded by Hacko to approve the agenda with the addition of B-2) ZBA Recommendation. Motion CARRIED (6-0)

Motion by Smith seconded by Bassett to accept the consent agenda as presented. Motion CARRIED (6-0)

Public Comment: None.

Motion by Smith seconded by Bassett to approve 405 S Muenscher driveway payout along with one other driveway during this fiscal year. Motion CARRIED (6-0)

Motion by Williams seconded by Smith to allow the Zoning Board of Appeals to go ahead with special land use permit for 25 acres on Hazel Street. Motion CARRIED (6-0)

Motion by Smith seconded by Bassett to approve the bills totaling \$25,576.50. Motion CARRIED (6-0)

Motion by Smith seconded by Hacko to allow Mr. Falcon to receive additional bids on extending the sewer line on Henkel to service potential businesses. Motion CARRIED (5-0) Heckman – Abstained

Motion by Williams seconded by Smith to turn over Medical Marijuana to the Planning Commission. Motion CARRIED (6-0)

Mr. Falcon thanked all the councilmembers for attending and helping with Bark in the Park. Mr. Falcon asked for constructive criticism regarding the event. The Council would like to have the event again next year. Mr. Falcon will ask the Park and Recreation Committee to help plan next year's event.

Mr. Falcon asked for help with the following day's Music in the Park. Cheryl Smith will give the check to the band and handle the announcing as well.

Public Comment: Mr. Baker thanked the Council for adding the second public comment section.

Trustee Hacko wanted everyone to know that there has been a recent increase of break-ins of vehicles. Please keep an eye out and also lock your cars.
